1) Introduction

According to the educational reforms introduced in 1998, the school library, the audiovisual unit, and the Computer Lab of the school were combined and re-named as the School Library and Learning Resource Centre (SLLRC). Accordingly, the role of the School / Teacher Librarian has become teaching information skills, supporting teaching and facilitating independent learning of the students etc. By this, it is expected to improve the quality of the resource-based teaching and learning processes. The Diploma in School Librarianship aims to provide the appropriate knowledge, attitude and skills required to fulfill the new roles and to produce a group of professionals who can shoulder these new transformations.

3) Entry Requirements

Passing GCE (A / L) Old Syllabus: Passing 03 subjects.

New Syllabus: Passing 03 main subjects.

OR

Passing GCE (O/L) and the Certificate in School Librarianship (CSL) /Advanced Certificate in School Librarianship (ACSL) or Advanced Certificate in Librarianship (ACL) awarded by the National Institute of Library and Information Sciences (NILIS).

After completing this course, the participants will be able to


- Understand the new trends in the school library,
